

Working together to make agri-food sector circular



On the 6th of October a webinar was organised in the frame of the circular week to discuss the challenges of the agri-food sector and the possible solutions.

90 minutes, 73 participants, 6 projects, 2 global challenges. The online webinar “making the agri-food sector circular” gave floor to six different European Green Deal projects. They all operate in the agri-food sector to find new technologies and solutions to the biggest problems the agri-food industry is facing: greenhouse gas emissions and food losses and waste.

Each project had 10 minutes to present their goals, challenges and research methodologies. However, each project does it from a slightly different angle. This is why dialogue and networking is essential to get the whole picture.

The webinar was very participated. People were actively involved, particularly during the Q&A sessions and the final roundtable, showing interest and curiosity towards the other projects.
